Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000. PLANS MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE A PERMIT CAN BE ISSUED.

VII. FEE CLARIFICATION

Form with text: ITEM #17 MOBILE HOME UNIT SITE. WHEN installing a site service in a park, the permit application must include the application fee, service, plus the number of park sites. WHEN setting a HUD mobile home in a park, a permit must include the application fee, and a feeder. This shall be done by a licensed electrical contractor. When setting a HUD mobile home or a pre-manufactured home on private property, a permit must include the application fee, service and feeder.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFINDED OR REINSTATED.**

The Department will not discriminate against any individual or group because of race, sex, religion, age, national origin, color, marital status, handicap or political beliefs.

When ready for an inspection, call the Township providing as much advance notice as possible. The Township will need the job location and permit number.

When a permit is issued, the permit number will be prefixed by an PE (electrical permit).
